

## ***Cub Scout Pack 210 Information***

Meeting Location: Providence Presbyterian Church

Dens meet twice a month on Tuesday Nights @ 7 p.m.

New Tigers - Den 1 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of each month

Wolf Den 6: 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of each month

Bear Den 3/Den 4: 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of each month.

Webelos I (Den 5): 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of each month

Webelos Flaming Ninja Patrol: 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of each month

Pack Meetings are held on the 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of each month in the Church Fellowship Hall

There are usually no meetings scheduled for the 5<sup>th</sup> Tuesday

### ***Den Dues***

To help cover the cost of materials for projects and crafts, Pack 210 asks for \$2 per month (\$24 per year) in Den Dues.

This is payable weekly or you can pay all at once if you prefer.

### ***Camping***

Pack 210 typically goes camping in the spring and fall each year. This is a family camping situation. Scouts can only attend with a parent or legal guardian. The Pack does not supply food or camping equipment on these outings. You are required to provide everything you need for the camp outs. There is also an associated cost with camping – typically \$12 for Scouts and \$6 for parents and siblings at Council events. If the Pack decides to go on a non-council event the cost may be more.

The Pack also participates in Resident Camp in the summer. This is a 4 day camping activity sponsored by Tuscarora Council. At Resident Camp your food is included in the cost of registration. The cost for Resident camp is usually \$125 for Scouts and \$50 for adults. The Pack has fund-raisers during the year to try and raise money to help offset the price of camp for any Scout that wants to participate.

Each new Scout needs to purchase a handbook and a uniform.

**The handbook is very important. Even if you cannot get your uniform immediately, please make every effort to get a handbook as soon as possible!**

Uniforms are also a very important part of Scouting.

### Uniforms

If you have a new **Tiger, Wolf or Bear** Scout you will need:

Hat, Neckerchief and Slide for his specific rank

Cub Scout Belt

Blue Cub Scout Uniform Shirt  
(we do not require Official uniform pants)

You will also need the following patches for the uniform:

Tuscarora Council Shoulder Patch,  
World Scouting Emblem  
Den Emblem (specific to his Den #)  
Pack Numerals (2, 1, 0)

If you have a new **Webelos I or II** you will need:

Webelos Hat, Neckerchief and Slide

Cub Scout Belt  
(the Cub belt fits the belt loops that the Scouts earn)

Tan Boy Scout Uniform Shirt  
(we do not require Official uniform pants)

You will also need the following patches for the uniform:

Tuscarora Council Shoulder Patch  
World Scouting Emblem  
Den Emblem (WEBELOS I) or Patrol Emblem (WEBELOS II)  
Pack Numerals (2, 1, 0)

Neckerchief \$5.99

Slide \$3.99

Belt \$7.99

Blue Cub Scout Shirt \$22.99

Tan WEBELOS Shirt \$24.99

### ***Required Insignia***

Tuscarora Council Strip \$2.20

Scouting World Crest \$1.49

Den Emblem (specific to each den) \$1.49

Patrol Emblem (WEBELOS II only) \$1.99

Pack Numerals 2, 1, and 0 \$3.57 (\$1.19 each)

### ***Handbooks***

Tiger Cub \$6.99 (\$12.99 spiral bound)

Wolf, Bear and WEBELOS \$8.99 (\$14.99 spiral bound)

This should be a one-time cost. At our Crossover Ceremony in May, the Pack presents each Scout that has earned rank with a handbook for the next rank in Scouting.
